Our theme this half term is 'Where are they?'

This unit of work provides the opportunity to further explore the seasons. Children will focus on the changes that take place during winter and how those changes impact both the environment around us and animals in the UK. The children will explore different animal habitats and how they are adapted. Children will be introduced to some events that mark new beginnings such as Easter and the Lunar New Year.

This week <u>all</u> children in Reception have word bags, which is super. Please make sure the children bring their folders to school everyday (even if they have not read their words at home). WE can then support them during the school day to read the words and bring the next bag home (18 in total).

This week the children have enjoyed exploring the Wintery environment (finding Evergreen and Deciduous trees), mark making following winter patterns and playing in the winter tough tray. The children have continued their love of playing matching pairs games and have enjoyed finding numbers and representations from 0 to 5.
