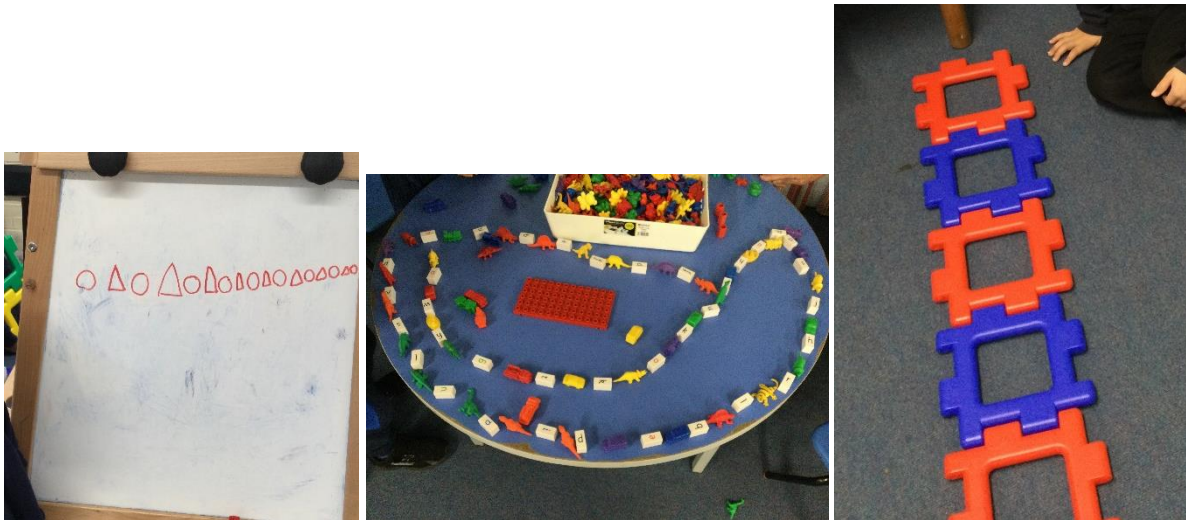


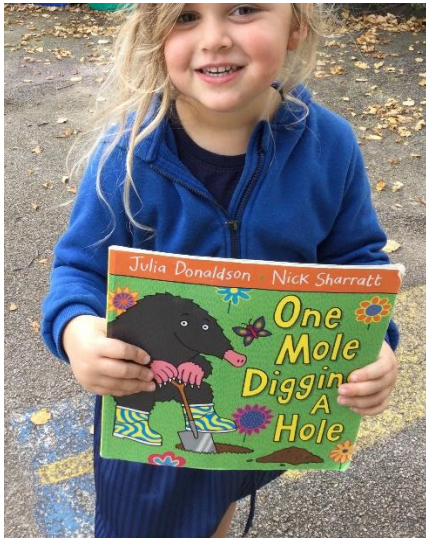
Acorn update: 13.10.23

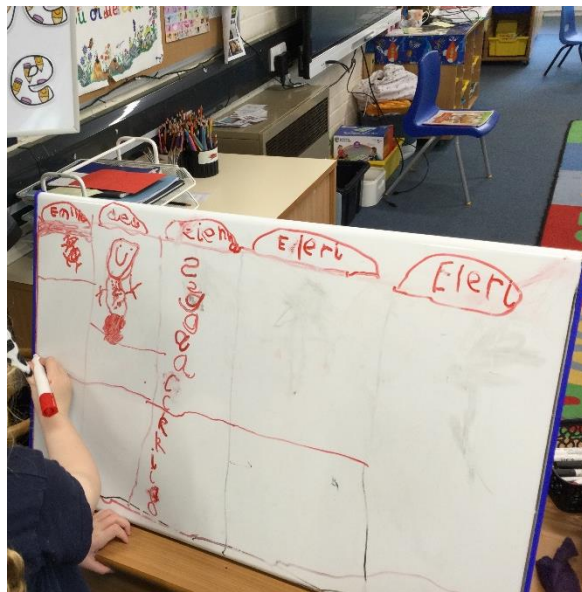
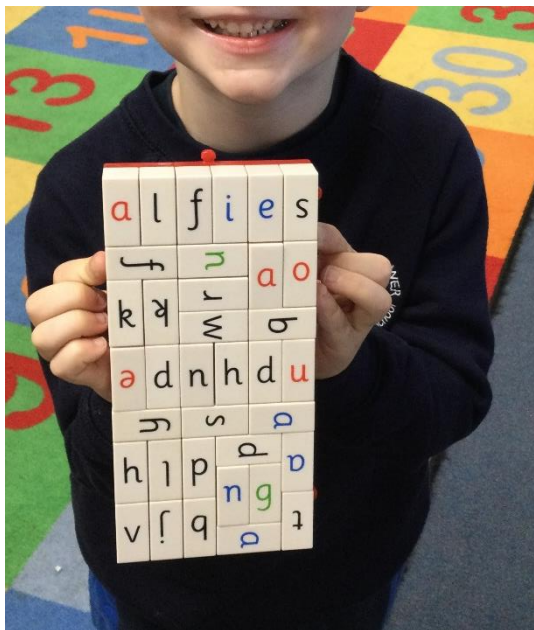
