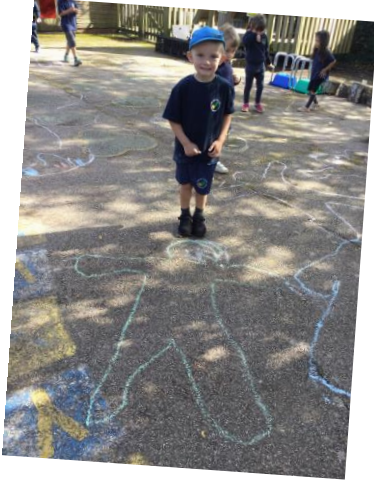
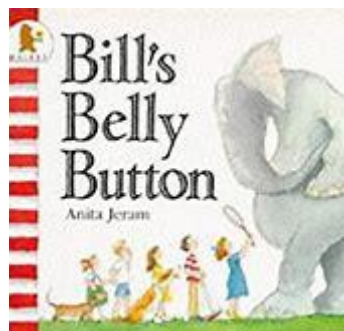


Acorn Update: Friday 15th September 2023

The Little Acorns have been decorating paper dolls and using their imaginations to create stories about them after listening to the story by Julia Donaldson of the same name.



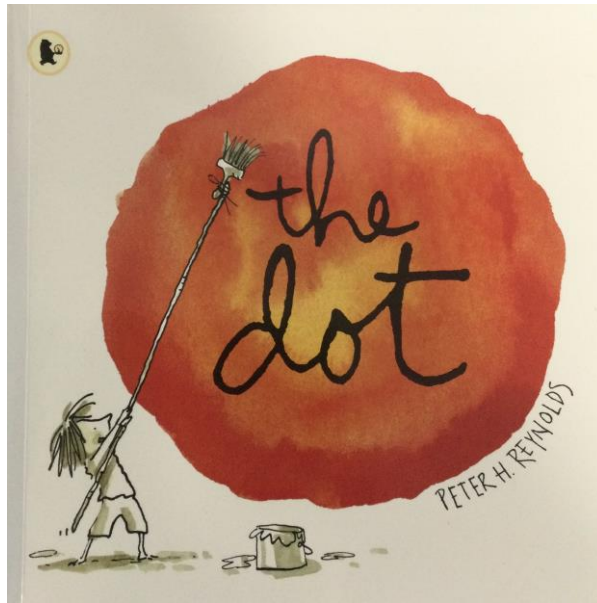
The children have enjoyed learning through play in the Acorn environment. They have been involved in a lot of problem solving, communication and team work to achieve superb results.
