

Acorn update – Friday 2nd July 2021

It has been another week full of learning, which has flown by!

This week the children have been writing and receiving letters linked to our class book 'Wild' by Emily Hughes. They have given some fantastic ideas and suggestions during class discussions as to what the characters in the story should do next. Ms O'Sullivan was so impressed with all the writing that she gave each child a head teacher's award sticker.

In grammar the children have been reading and writing question words, such as, what, where, when, who. Some children then found these in their reading books. Some children said they had been telling grown-ups at home all about tricky question words!

In maths this week, the children in reception have been working on addition to 10 whilst year 1 children have been sequencing numbers up to 100. All the children have been revising 3D shapes, talking about how many faces each shape has, describing their properties using vocabulary such as curved or flat face and sorting everyday 3D objects into groups.

As part of our learning in science, we have been finding out about different life cycles. We have learnt about the life cycle of a frog, butterfly and ladybird. We cut out pictures and stuck them in the correct order to show the sequence of events.

On Wednesday, we went to the village pond for our forest school session. We enjoyed spotting tadpoles, froglets and even newts! We sat and looked closely at the different creatures on, in and above the water and spotted many beautiful dragonflies. We then carefully drew what we had observed.

In French this week, we have been learning about different sports in readiness for the upcoming Olympics. We all practiced saying what sports we 'do' – Je fais, or play 'Je joue' and then sung a French song about playing sport to the tune of The wheels on the bus.

Sports Day: We have sent each parent an email to let you know what colour house your child is in. Children will need to wear a t shirt that is the same colour as their house team.
