

Acorn update: Friday 6th October 2023

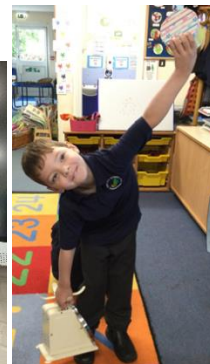
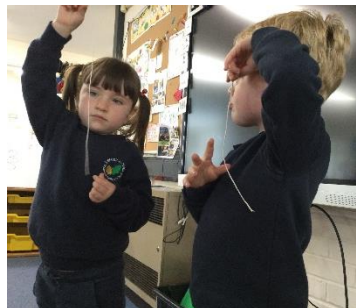

In Maths, the children are learning about Comparing Size. They have been using vocabulary such as *big and small* and *heavy and light*, to compare objects. The children became human balance scales this week as we compared the mass of two objects.
