### **Phonics:**

The children in Reception have already started their learning in phonics, using the school scheme Jolly Phonics. The folder which has been sent home (with this update in), is to stay at home for you to collect the phoneme sheets in. These sheets are to support your child in practising the actions, which match the phonemes (sounds), they do not need to be brought back into school. This week the children have learnt **s** and **a**. Please do not worry about the letter formation if your child is not ready, but do encourage a little colouring to support development in fine motor, pencil control and pencil grip. If you need any tips on pencil grip, please just ask.

#### **Books:**

All the children in Acorn are invited to take a book home each afternoon. These are for a family adult to read to their child during the evening. Once the book is returned, another book can be chosen.

#### **Class Theme:**

This half term our theme is 'This is me', the children have already been drawing and painting their families and talking about what they like and do not like. We have been talking about how we are all different and all amazing.

#### Homework for week beginning 18.9.23

We will be looking at how we have changed the week after next and would like to ask if your child could bring in **ONE photo of themselves as babies**. Then we can play 'guess the baby!' and talk about how they have changed. We will happily photocopy original photos, as we know how precious they are.
