

Beech Class Weekly Update

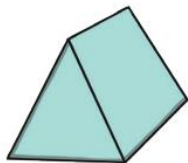

This week, we have been learning about 3D shapes. You could carry this on at home:



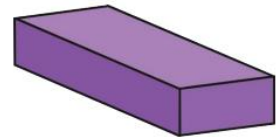
square-based pyramid



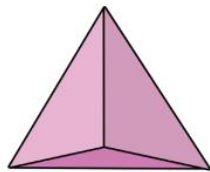
triangular prism

cuboid



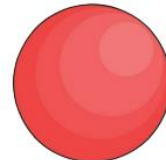
triangular-based
