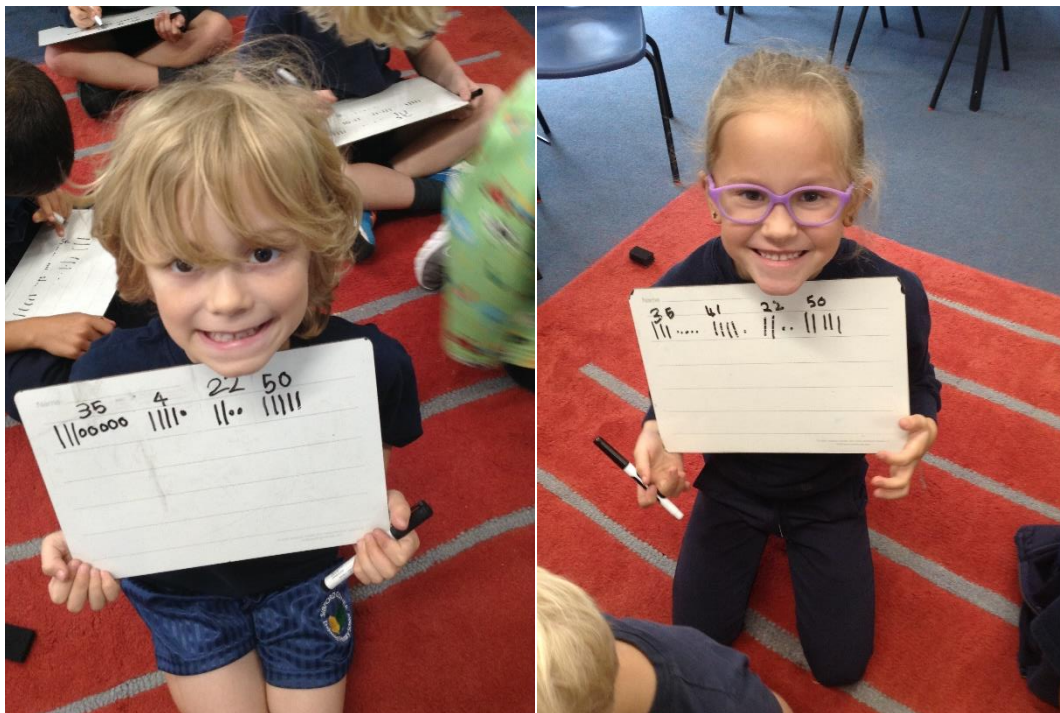


## Beech Class Weekly Update Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023

In maths, we continue our place value learning journey. To support this at home, you could practise counting forwards and backwards.

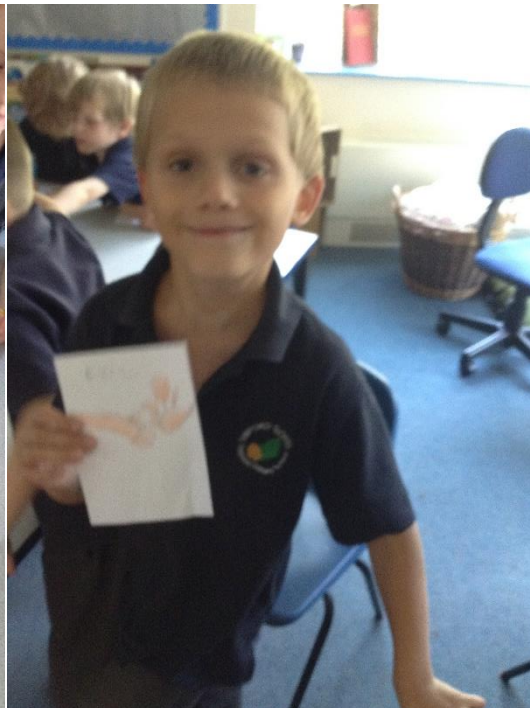
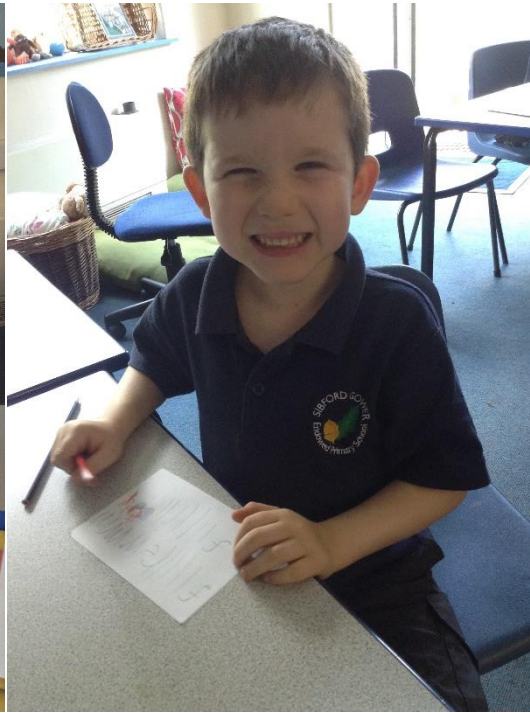
