Year I math focus this week: Subtraction (by taking away/crossing out) Year I math focus for next week:

Subtraction on a numberline

Year 2 math focus for next week:

Adding and subtracting 10s. You could use this 100 square at home to find 10 more or 10 less than a number. Why not test each other for fun?!
