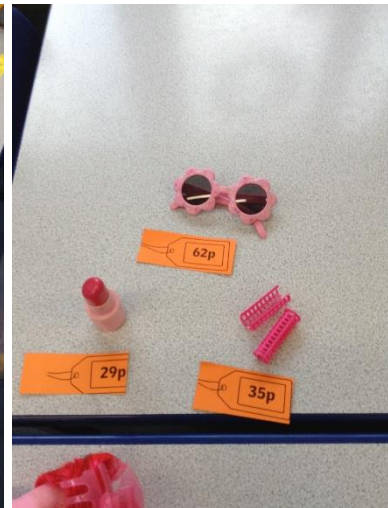


Beech Class Weekly Update Friday 27th January 2023

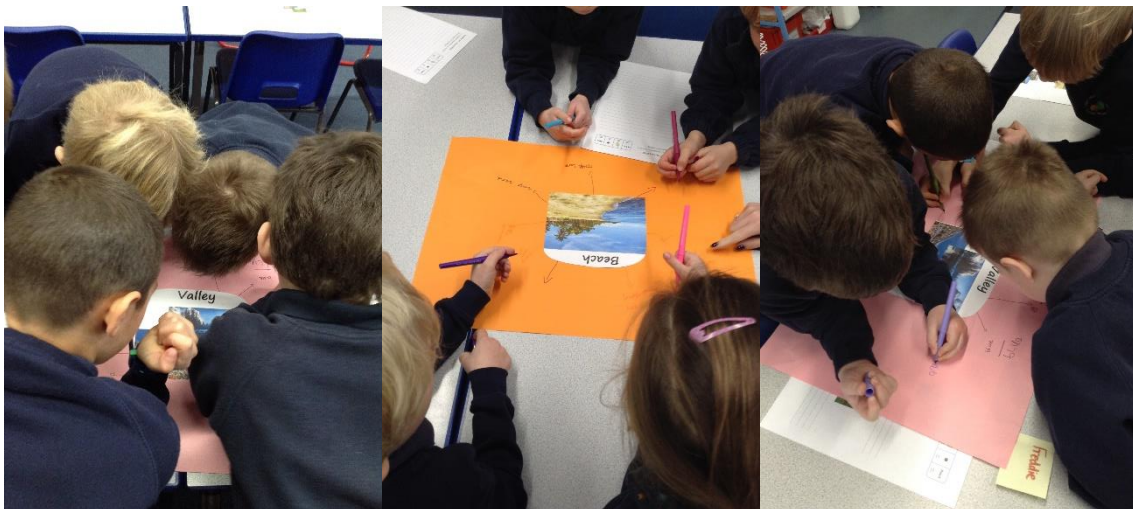
In gymnastics we learnt about the importance of developing strength and tension in supporting our balance when holding different poses.
