Creative Writing (literacy)

We are going to take full advantage of this storm and have a go at creating some wonderful writing about it.

1. You could create an acrostic poem for the word STORM. Using a range of descriptive features to describe each letter (Alliterations, adjectives, onomatopoeia and similes). You could also decorate your poem just like we would do in school. Remember, capital letters.
2. Create a story that connects with a storm. Think about your structure and vocabulary. You might be on a desert island and a storm happens or just like Oliver from our book, he sets off to find someone yet gets caught in a storm. You ALL have wonderful imaginations so 'think outside the box' and ENJOY!

Your task is to come up with some potential storm names for this season. You must include a mixture of male and female names. Storms are not named using the letters Q, U, X Y or Z.


