



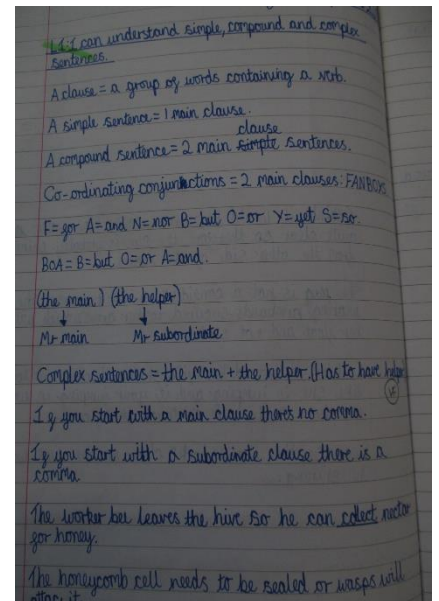
Weekly Update – 2nd October
