**Maths Homework**

**Length**  
 1 kilometre = 1000 metres  
 1 metre = 100 centimetres  
 1 centimetre = 10 millimetres

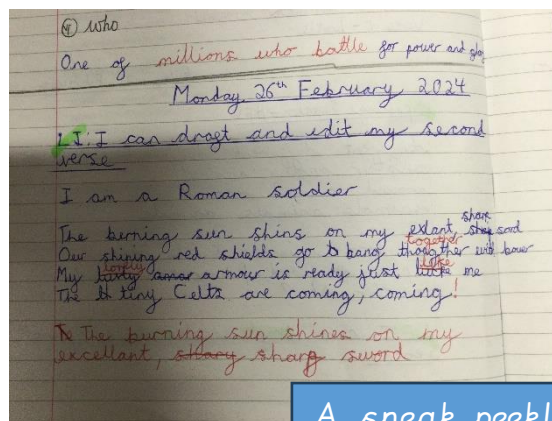
## Literacy

WOW! I have been blown away this week.

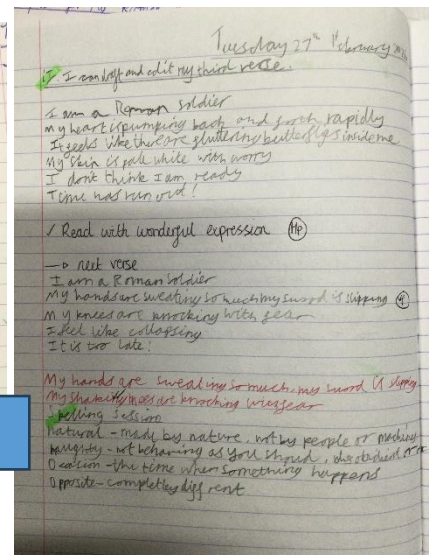
We have finished our 'Roman Soldier' poems. The children have
