



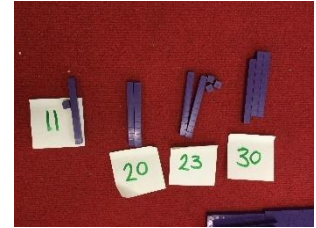

We have also been working hard on our 'Maths Mastery'- Explaining how we achieved our answer, explaining in steps how to work out an answer and proving it.

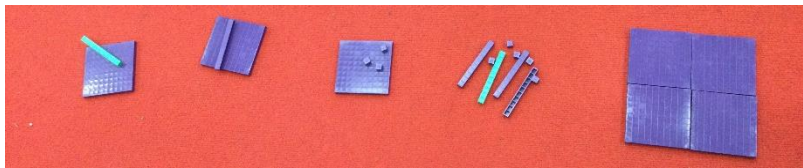
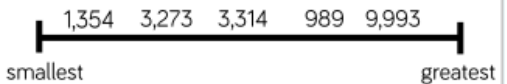
Maths challenge for home- If you have a spare minute, have a go at the 'problem solving task' Enjoy!
