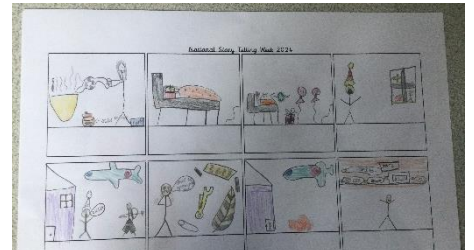
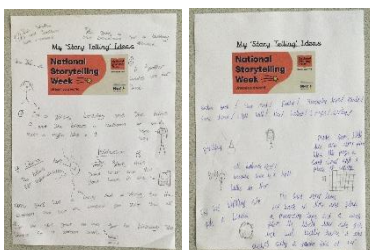


We have had a fabulous week, listening to different stories. One of our favourite stories was 'The Rowan Tree'.
