Another fabulous week in maths. Our brains have been working extremely hard! We have been working on partitioning numbers, representing numbers and fully understanding place value!

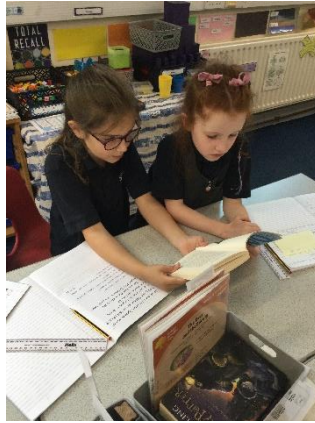


Book Club
