



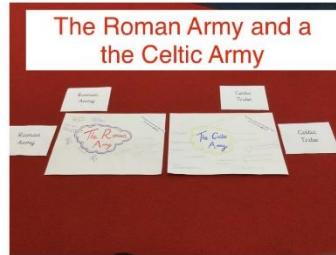

Who was more effective?



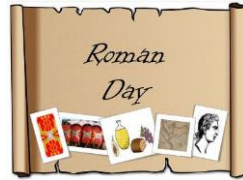
