

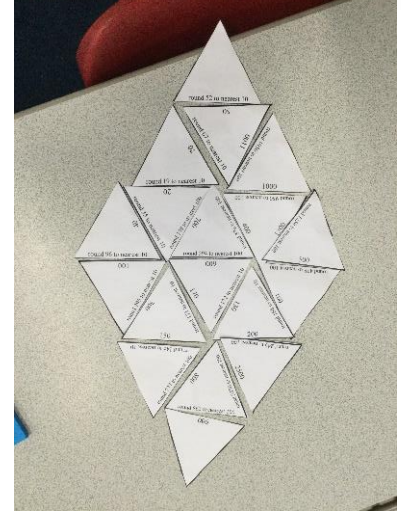


# Weekly Update

## Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2024

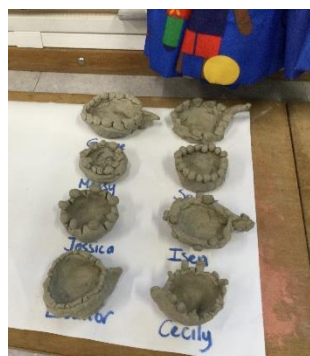
