

## **Acorn Update: Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2024**

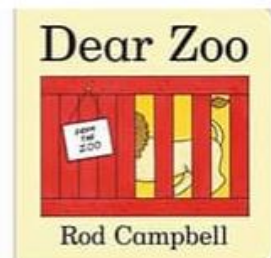
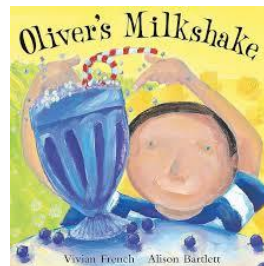
