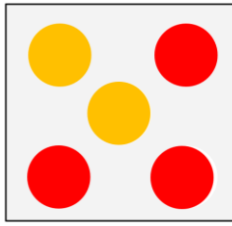


# WOMBATS

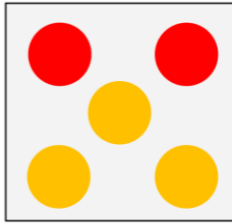

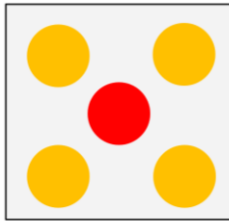
Maths: Year 1 have been working on their number bonds to 5

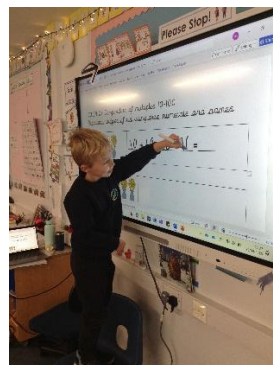

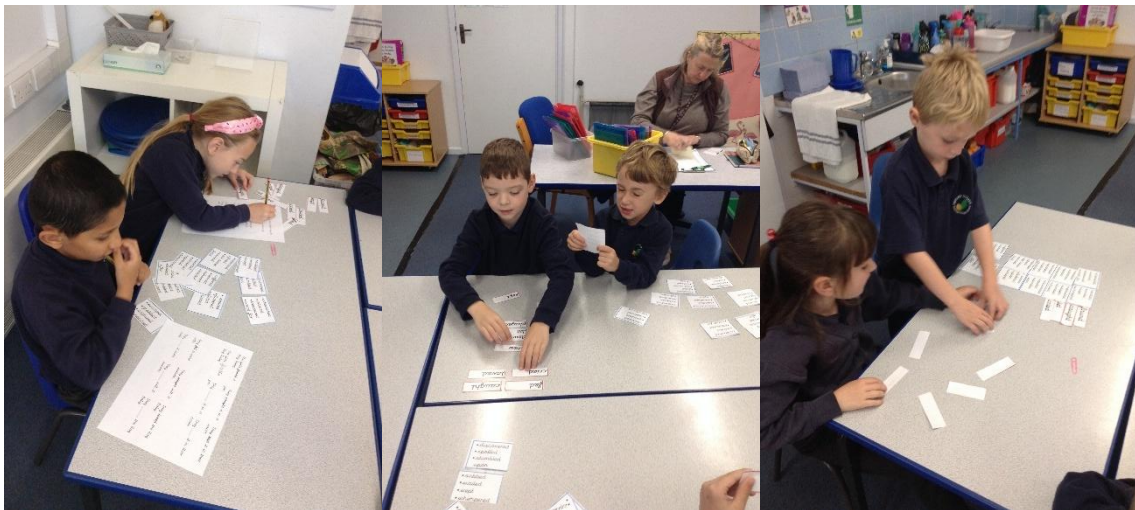
Marbles are packed into boxes of ten.
