### **Morning task:**

#### Reception children

- Watch the video to explain the 'CVC word and Picture matching' phonics for this morning (if you are unable to access the video: children need to segment and blend words for reading and then draw a line to match the picture to the correct word. This is Phonics day 2 in your packs)

#### Year 1

- Watch the video (from Monday) of the spelling pattern for this week and practise reading and writing the words with ea in (previously taught as ee)
- Watch today's phonics video - Now have a go at writing some 'ea' words on the Teapot pictures in your packs.
- **2 Times Table Activities – this is a new morning task activity. You can do it at any time of day to fit in with your routine.**
- **Watch the video to explain the task (if you are unable to access the video, it is sheet 1 in your times tables pack).**

### **English:**

- Today we are going to be learning some more about Bees.

- Now, talk with someone about what you have learnt about Bees.
- Now, have a go at making a Bee fact file using the information you have learnt and anything else you already know. You could do this in your book or make a poster or I have **set it as a To-do on purple mash** if you would like a template – however you would like to. Make it colourful and contain lots of information you have learnt.
- Remember to send me a picture on Purple Mash

**Topic:**

- Now we are going to learn about the life cycle of a Bee. A life cycle shows how a creature is born to when it dies. It is also how a creature grows from a baby to an adult.
- Watch the Life cycle of a Bee, an audio PowerPoint which has been put on Purple Mash for you to listen to and watch today. I have recorded the words so you just need to watch and listen.
- Create your own Life cycle of a bee, either by using the [sheet on Purple Mash](#) or by drawing and labelling your own.
- This is a cutting and sticking activity, so you should enjoy it. There are two life cycles to complete.
