wonderful wings

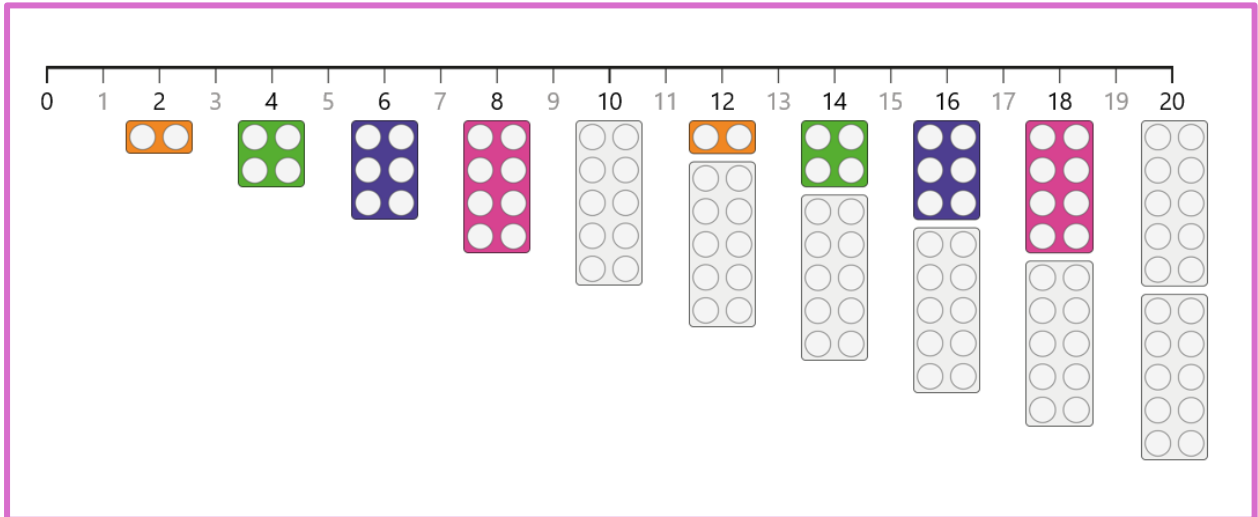


Thank you for taking the time to come to my math's workshop. The children were asking me how their grown ups had behaved in the, 'lesson!'

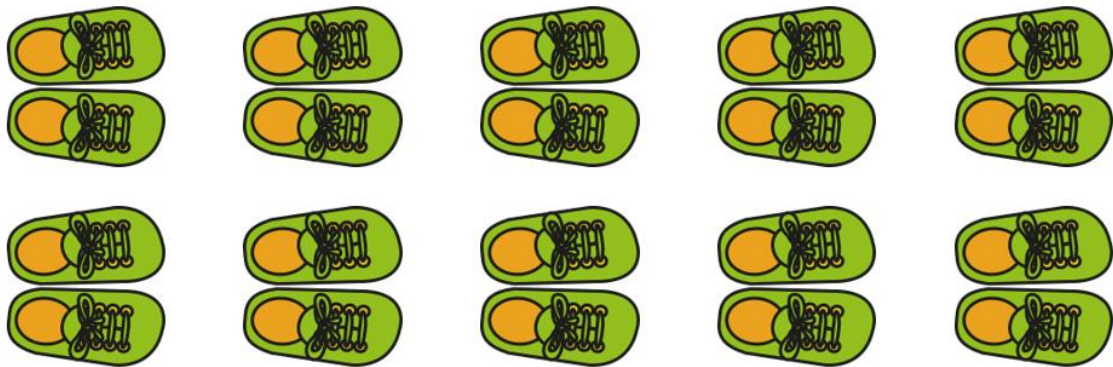
This week, in maths, we have been counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10. It would be great if you could work on this at home.

Counting in 2s



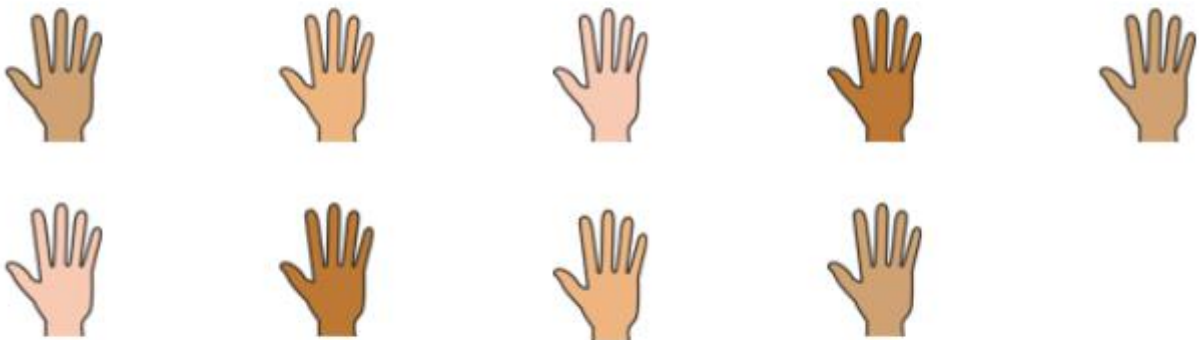
How many shoes are there?
Count in groups of two.



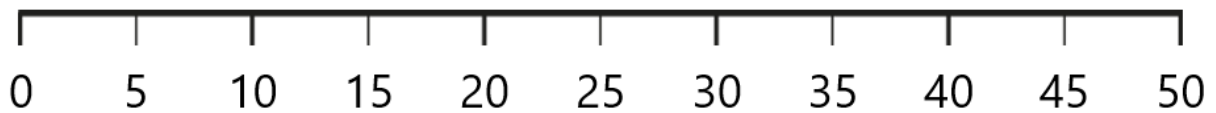

Count in groups of five.



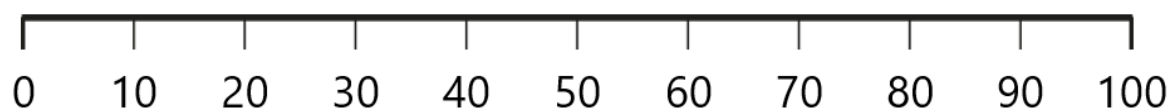
forty-five

Counting in 10s

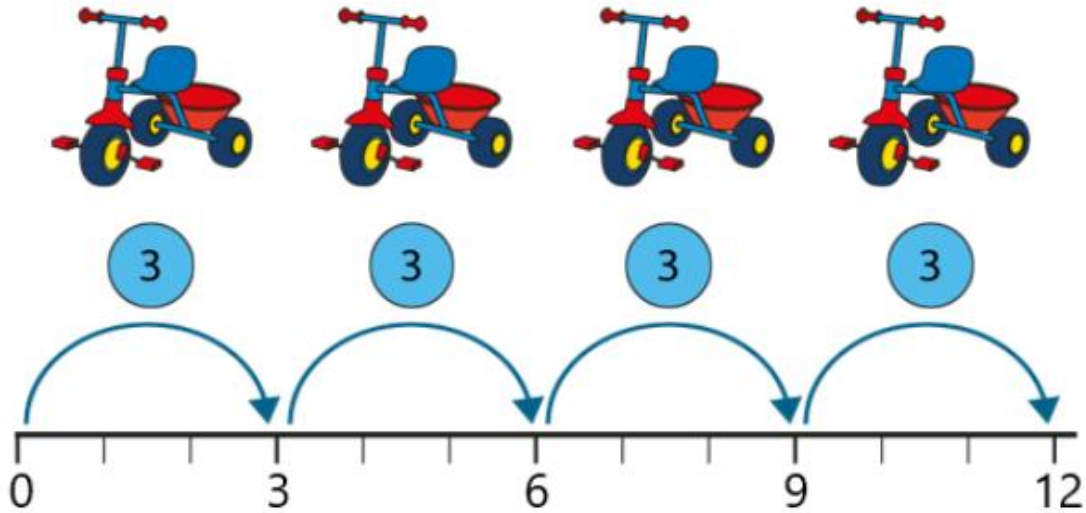


'Nine groups of ten.'
