The book corner in Willow Class is a really nice place to sit and read!



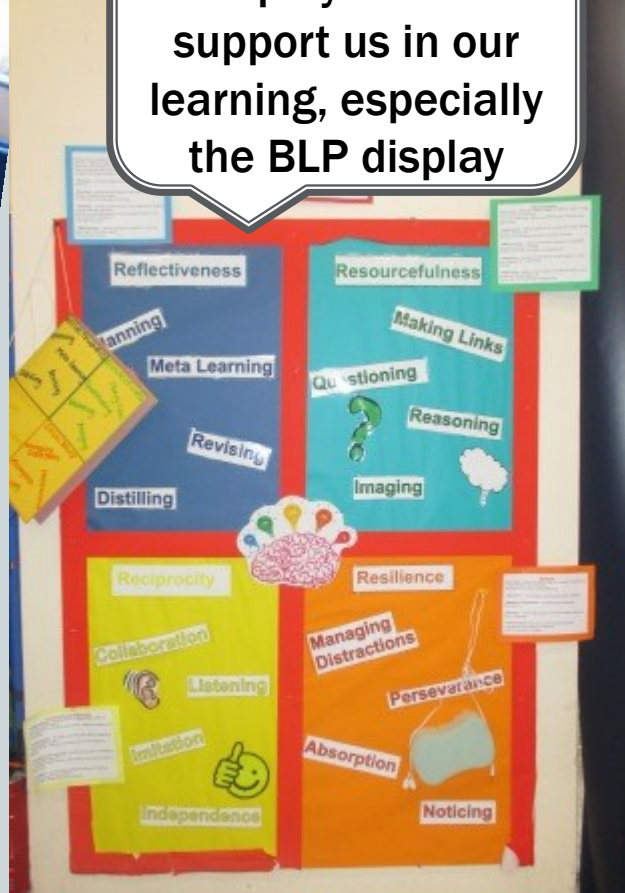
We need to keep our washroom a bit tidier and put paper towels in the bin!

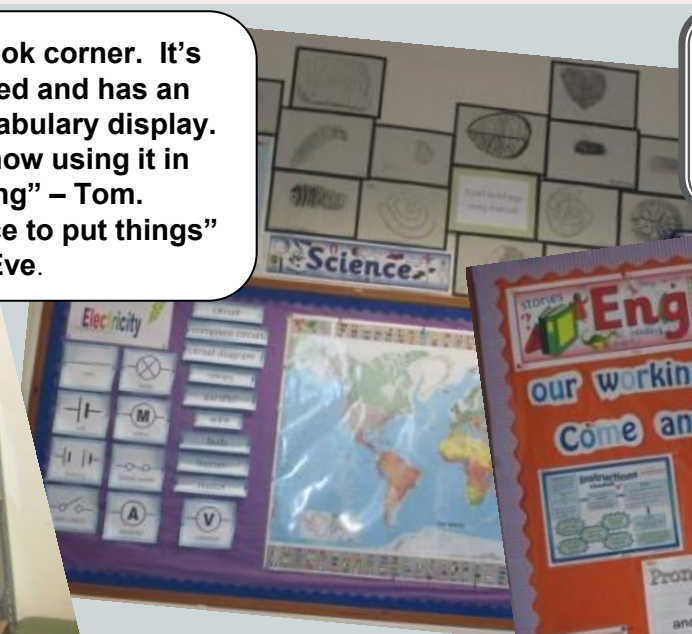
We also love the displays which support us in our learning, especially the BLP display

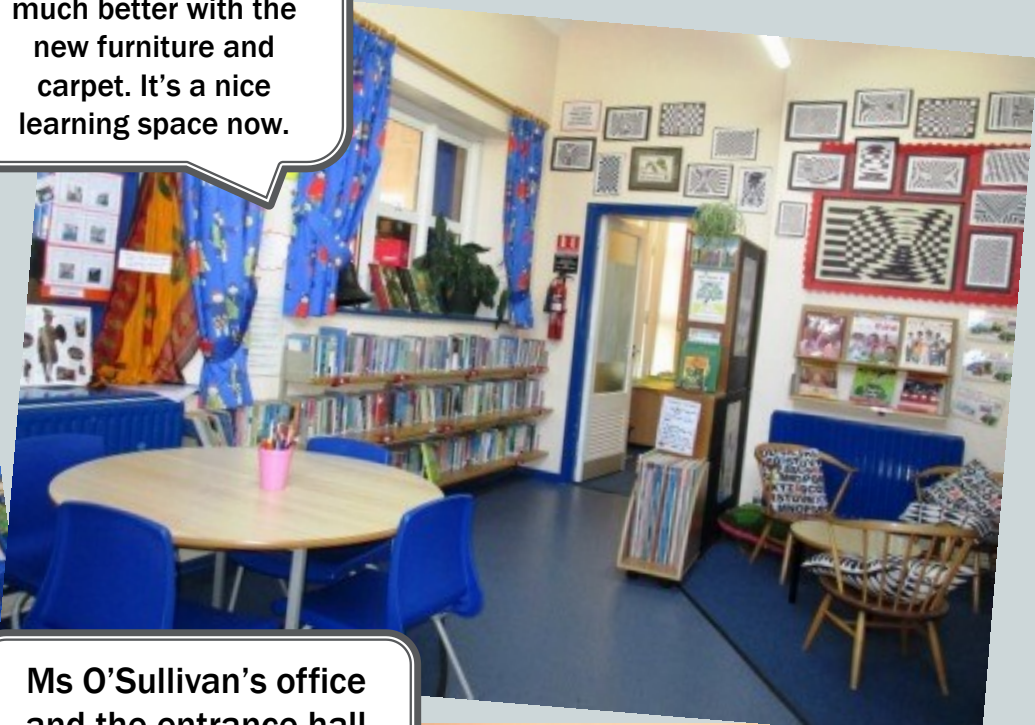
The library looks so much better with the new furniture and carpet. It's a nice learning space now.
