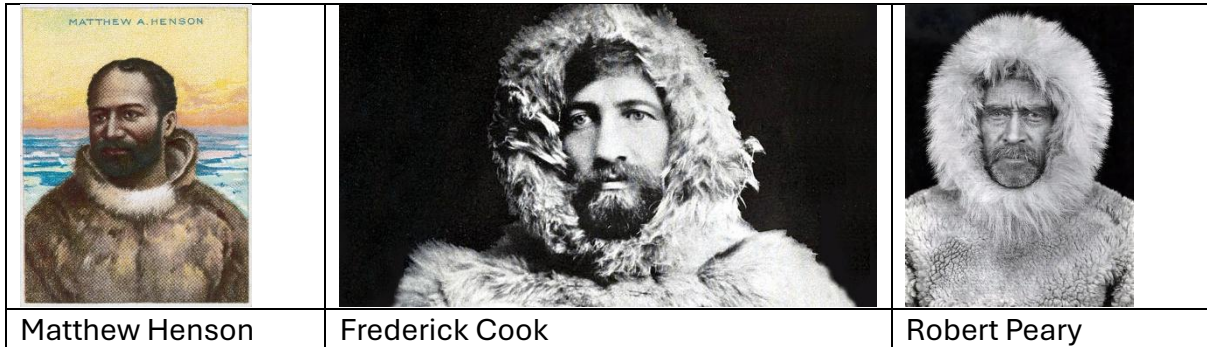


Week beginning 24th November 2025

History and Geography:

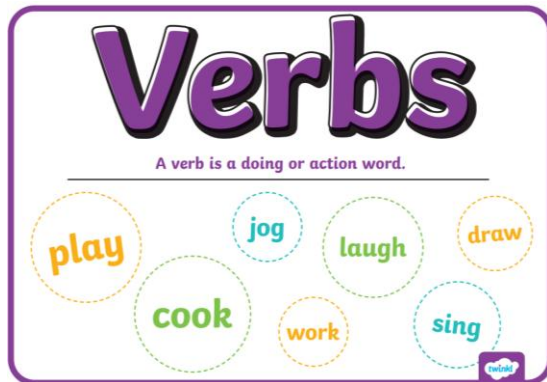


The children enjoyed a lively geography lesson focused on an exciting debate about who reached the North Pole first. They learned about early explorers and discussed different viewpoints, sharing their ideas confidently and listening carefully to one another. The debate encouraged curiosity about the world, developed speaking and listening skills, and helped the children understand that history and geography can sometimes have differing accounts. The children showed great enthusiasm and thoughtful contributions throughout the discussion.



They also learned about the location of the Arctic, finding it on maps and globes, and explored the animals that live there. The children enjoyed discovering how Arctic animals are adapted to the cold environment and shared lots of thoughtful ideas during discussions, showing great enthusiasm and curiosity about the world around them.

The children focused on developing their understanding of verbs and adverbs in English. They learned how verbs describe actions and how adverbs add more detail by explaining how actions are done. Through fun activities and practical examples, the children enjoyed identifying verbs and adverbs in sentences and using them in their own speaking and writing, showing growing confidence and enthusiasm.
