

## Funded Early Education Funding places

### When is my child eligible?

This table refers to children who are eligible for funding. More specifically:

- 9-23 month working parent entitlement – up to 30 hours per week starting from the term after their 9-month birthday. Apply through [Childcare Choices](#)
- 2-year-old working parent entitlement– up to 30 hours per week starting from the term after their 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday. Apply through [Childcare Choices](#)
- 3- & 4-year-olds working parent entitlement – up to 30 hours per week starting from the term after their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday. Apply through [Childcare Choices](#)
- 3 & 4-year-olds universal funding (children not eligible for working parent entitlement) – up to 15 hours per week starting from the term after their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday. No application or code needed.
- 2-year-old 15 hours early learning funding for families in England receiving some additional forms of support – starting the term after their 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday. Apply through [Oxfordshire County Council](#)
- \*Please be aware that the maximum number of funded hours for any child is 30. If a child is in receipt of both working parent entitlement and early learning funding for families in England receiving some additional forms of support, then settings should claim the first 15 hours using the Oxfordshire County Council provided 2-year-old code and up to 15 additional hours can be claimed using the working parent code.

Those children who have deferred their primary school place and remain in a nursery class can receive - up to 15 universal hours per week or an extended 15 hours if eligible for the working parent entitlement. If you are a school, you must make sure you identify in your MIS that the child's year group is adjusted. These children should not be included in your school census (as a reception child). Children can only be claimed up until compulsory school age (the term after their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday).
