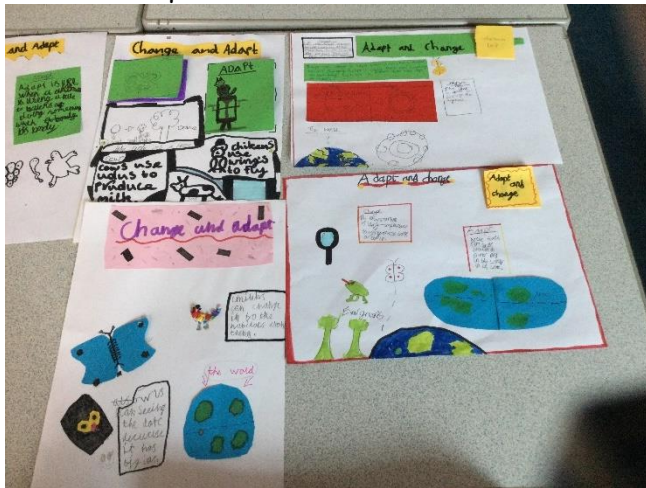
Friday 14th March 2025
