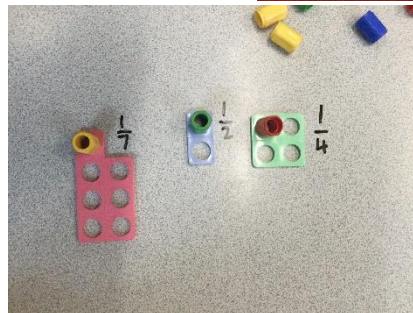
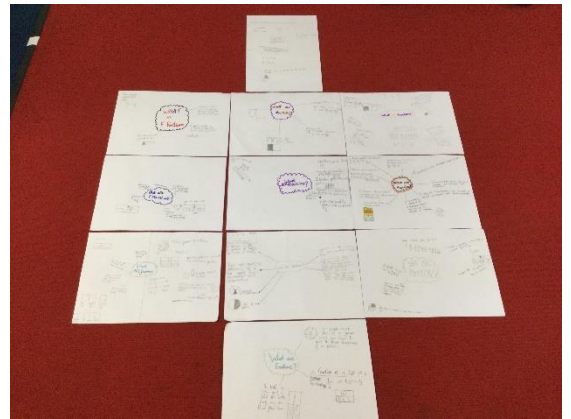

Maths

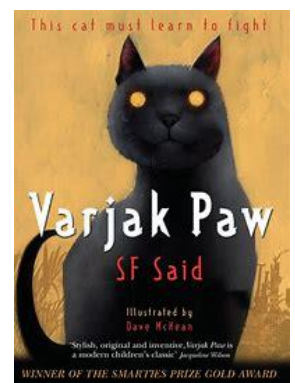
We have started our learning journey on Fractions this week. We started by finding out what we remembered and what we wanted to find out. I was extremely impressed with the children's honesty. Many children expressed that they find fractions difficult- as a class we reassured everyone and are now extremely determined and motivated to learn about fractions. Already, some children have swapped and they now enjoy learning about fractions (yay!)



We were creative and used our mathematical resources to help us understand the concept of fractions and to help us understand what numerators and denominators are.

Literacy

The children have been working extremely hard this week; their focus and creativity has been so lovely to be part of. They have finished their very own narratives. (one proud teacher!) I set an extra challenge of including speech.



To help us remember what is needed when using speech, we came up with our very own actions to help. Ask them to show you 😊
