World Postcard Day



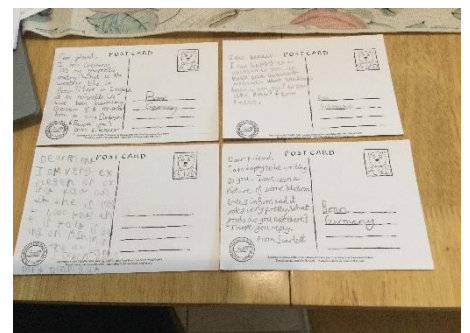
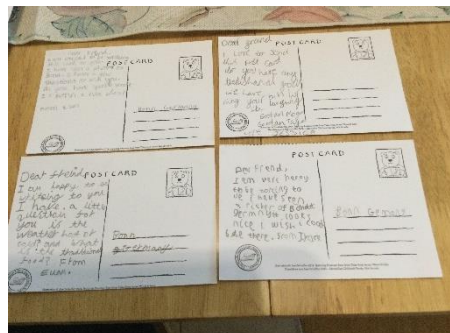
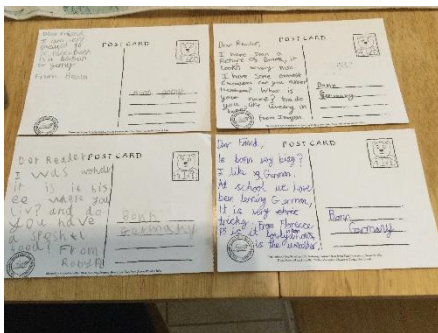
We celebrated World Postcard Day on Tuesday 1st October. Everyone's favourite illustrator, Axel Scheffler designed this year's post card.
